

The Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program has helped more than 350,000 Florida students attend college. The three levels of scholarship awards are:

Florida Academic Scholars award (FAS)
Florida Medallion Scholars award (FMS)
Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars award (GSV).

If you already have the Florida Prepaid College Plan, you still can obtain the Bright Futures Scholarship. The Bright Futures Scholarship you earn can be used to cover the college expenses you prepaid plan does not cover.

- It is the student's responsibility to plan ahead and stay informed, in order to meet the requirements of the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program.
- It is also the student's job to earn the necessary Grade Point Average (GPA) in the required high school classes.
- Even if the student is not sure about college, apply for a Bright Futures Scholarship during your senior year.
- Students, who apply by their graduation date and are found eligible, have up to three years from high school graduation to begin using the scholarship.
