

## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

### 1. Step Up for Students



SUFS is an income-based scholarship with eligibility determined by the state. Parents may apply and check eligibility requirements online at [www.stepupforstudents.com](http://www.stepupforstudents.com). All supporting documentation must be submitted. If you qualify, SUFS will notify you, the parent. It is the parent's responsibility to notify the school of their eligibility for SUFS. Any tuition or fees not covered by the scholarship is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Families receiving SUFS must reapply for the scholarship each year and are responsible for notifying the school concerning continued eligibility.

### 2. VPK (Voluntary Prekindergarten)



VPK is eligible only for Pre-K4. Any child entering the Pre-K4 program qualifies as long as they were born before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the school year. Application of eligible children requires a face-to-face visit by the guardians/parents with a Family Central VPK Parent Counselor. Any tuition or fees not covered by the scholarship are the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

### 3. McKay Scholarship



Eligibility for the McKay Scholarship is determined by the State of Florida. To qualify for the scholarship, the student must be transferring from a Florida public school with a current IEP or 504 Plan. Applying for the McKay Scholarship Program is the responsibility of the parents. All application deadlines for the scholarship are posted on the website at [www.floridaschoolchoice.org](http://www.floridaschoolchoice.org). ***(Note: the deadlines for filing a parental intent and private school enrollment are statutory deadlines – McKay will not make exceptions if these deadlines are missed. Please ensure that your child's enrollment application is submitted to Glades Day by the private school enrollment deadline date.)*** Students must meet Glades Day School's admission guidelines before being accepted **AND THEN** they are added to our McKay Student List with the state. The funded amount varies from student to student (determined by the state). The parent or guardian is responsible for the tuition balance.
